ABOUT EEI, NILOKHERI

Presently, four training institute are working in the country among them Extension Education Institute (EEI), Nilokheri is the first and oldest training institute which was established in the year 1959 by the Govt. of India. After January 1991, the overall Management and Administrative control of this institute was switched over to CCS Haryana Agricultural University, Hisar. Primarily it was established as a Extension Training Centre to strengthen the competence of the trainers/ instructors of Training Centers. Subsequently, the institute has been assigned the other responsibilities i.e. imparting



training to in-service officers of various departments including Agriculture, Horticulture, Animal Husbandry and Dairy, Fishery, Sericulture, Social Forestry, Rural Development and other land-based development departments; along with training to the Master Trainers/Scientists of Agricultural Universities (AUs), SAMETI sand NGOs etc. In addition, institute also organize training in the different areas like Extension Methodology, Skill Teaching, Training Management, Market-Led- Extension, Time, Conflict and Stress Management, Entrepreneurial Skills, Monitoring and Evaluation, Training Need Assessment, Personality Development, Communication, Media and Soft Skills, Decision Making and Motivational Skills, Information and Communication Technologies etc. The institute also conducts the courses on innovative approaches like Linking Farmers to Market and Processing Industries, Drone, GIS and GPRS and FPOs etc. The institute also conducts the capacity building programmes for the faculty/scientist/master trainer etc.

HOW TO REACH THE INSTITUTE

The institute is located at Nilokheri, which is situated on the main Delhi-Amritsar National Highway 44 in the Karnal district of Haryana, India. This location provides convenient access by both road and rail to major cities across the country. The Institute is 16 Km away from Karnal Bus Stand while 21 Km away from Karnal Railways Station. During night if you are coming by train and there is no stoppage of train at Karnal, then one option could be to take a train to Ambala Cantt. and then catch a bus to Nilokheri. Ambala Cantt is approximately 58 km away from Nilokheri and bus services readily available around the clock to make the onward journey to Nilokheri.

SANCTIONED POST

The institute has a total of 49 sanctioned posts. Out of which 10 posts are for teaching staff and 39 posts for non-teaching staff. Presently, there are 6 faculty members and 26 non-teaching staff are working in the institute.

INFRASTRUCTURE AND FACILITIES:

ADMINISTRATIVE BLOCK : It is an old and spacious building in round shape, catering to both administrative and educational needs, which comprises Regional Director's office, faculty member and ministerial staff chambers, computer lab and library. It is functional with 24 hours broad band service facility.

PARTICIPANTS' HOSTEL : A well-furnished participants' hostel of 24 rooms equipped with all the latest facilities such as Wi-Fi, AC, LCD TV, electric geyser, room heater, water dispenser and water cooler etc. It is used to provide lodging and boarding facilities to the participants. It also serves as a guest house for various dignitaries visiting the institute for official purposes.

LOUNGE : Lounge facility is also available in the participants' hostel with LCD and various magazine facilities for dignitaries and trainees. It is also utilized for meeting and greeting occasions.

SEMINAR HALL : It is used to impart training to the participants as well as meeting also. It is equipped with following facilities:

- Air Conditioners

SYNDICATE ROOM : It is used to complete the assignments and small meeting of the institute. Moreover, in the premises of seminar hall & syndicate room, the basic facilities such as water dispenser and gents/ladies washroom are also available.

LIBRARY : It provides the information support to its staff (teaching and non-teaching) and trainees. It is endowed with good collection of books on agricultural extension and allied subjects. The library has a large print collection of about 3,900 books and other reading materials. In addition, it is also enriched with various farm magazines and journals. Newspapers subscription by the library.

COMPUTER LAB: The lab has 20 computers with internet connectivity for completion of the assignments during the training programme.

CCTV CAMERAS : Campus is under 24×7 CCTV cameras surveillance for campus safety and monitoring.

WI-FI CAMPUS: Institute is having high speed internet facility. The campus has a 24×7 Wi-Fi facility in the premises viz. administrative block and participants' hostel area.

VEHICLE : The institute have a mini bus with seating capacity of 26 persons. This vehicle is used for organizing exposure visits for the trainees. One staff car is also available for official purposes.

STAFF QUARTERS : Institute has residential facilities for regional director, teaching and the non-teaching employees. In total, there are 08 quarters (Type A and B) at main campus. While institute has an officer colony also which is situated 2 km away from the main campus having 34 quarters (Type A, B, C and D). The campus provides 24 hours water supply and security to the residents and allotment is made on the eligibility fulfilments.

REGIONAL WORKSHOPS

It may be conducted once in a year for need assessment and finalization of the training areas for the next year. Institute finalize the annual training calendar during the fourth quarter of the financial year in the presence of representatives of all the client states/UTs and the concerned officials of funding agency i.e. Directorate of Extension, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare, Government of India, New Delhi. The deliberations are held to finalize of training areas and annual calendar for the upcoming financial year incorporating necessary suggestions from the delegates representing client states/UTs.

TYPES OF TRAINING CONDUCTED BY EEI

EEI, Nilokheri organizes basically two types of trainings/courses i.e. On-Campus and Off-Campus training programmes, which are designed on the basis of the training needs of Scientist/SMSs, Master Trainers and extension functionaries of client states/UTs with the objective to improve the socio-economic status of farming community. On-Campus trainings/courses programmes are organized at EEI, Nilokheri main campus while, Off- Campus trainings/courses are organized in collaboration with SAMETIs/AUs and agricultural departments as per their demand and training needs at their own institute/place. Paid courses are also conducted by the institutes on request and demand basis by NGO as per norms of the funding agency i.e., Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers' Welfare, Govt. of India, Directorate of Extension, New Delhi.

In the Financial Year 2023-24, EEI has planned 50 training programmes. Out of which 39 trainings has been successfully conducted and 972 extension functionaries participated from different states/UTs of the northern region of the country. The details are as under
